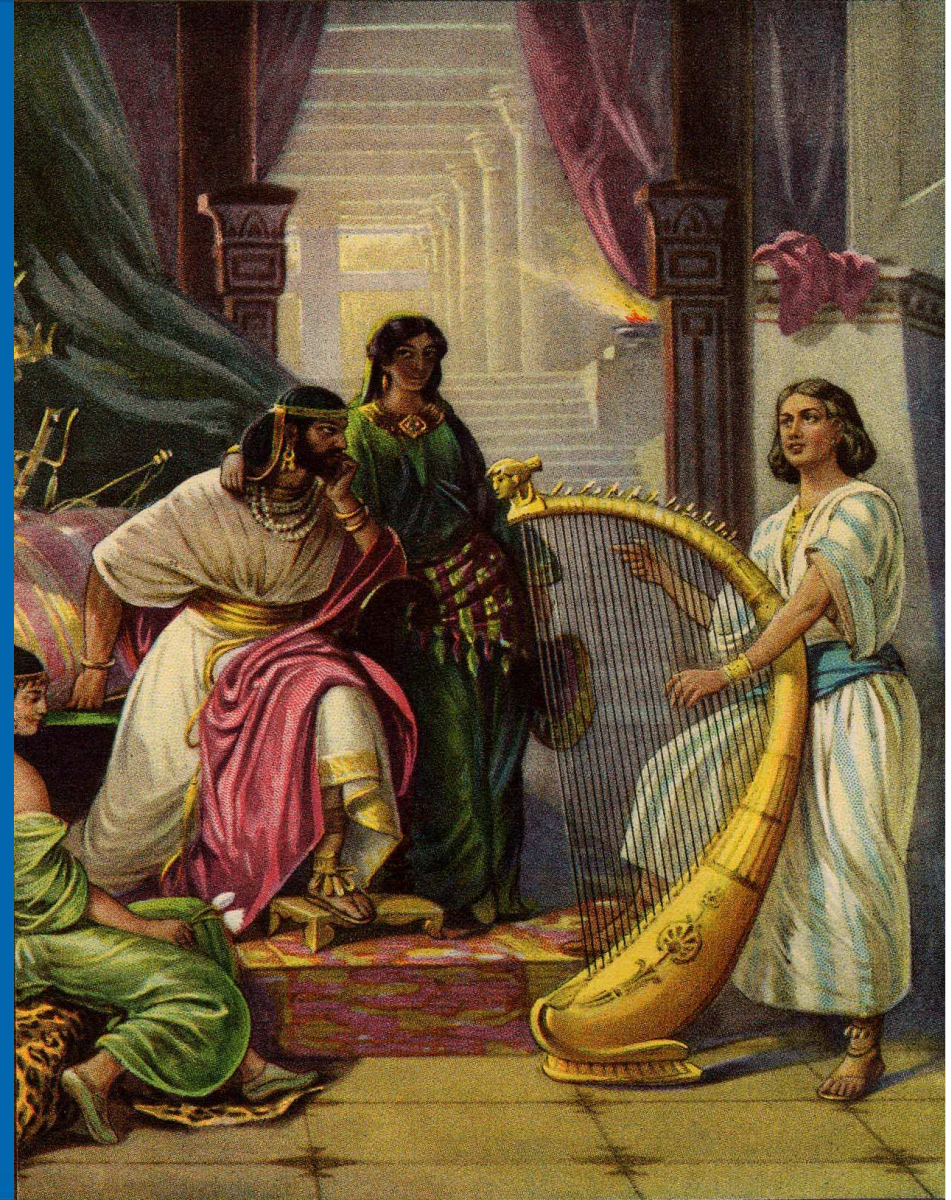

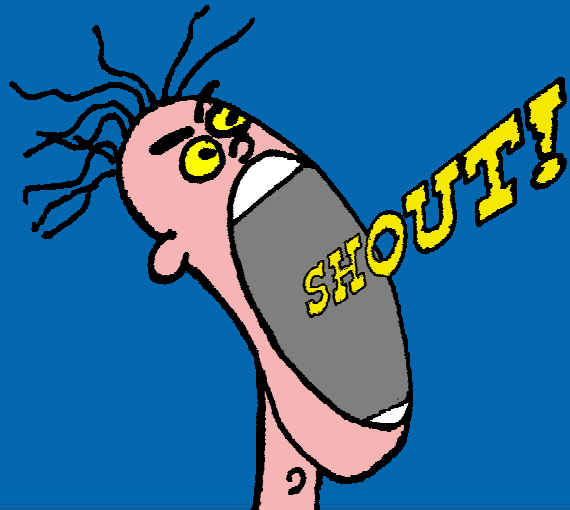

## Hebrew Words



**“HALAL”** - Shine, make a show, boast, rave, celebrate & give glory. Get vigorously excited in rejoicing. Be clamorously foolish. (eg. David dancing with the return of the ark)



**“SHABACH”** - Address Loudly in triumphing, shout! (eg Joshua & Jericho, Ps 117:1, 47:1, 37:27; 63:1-4)

## **Hebrew Words**

**“YADAH”** - *Extend & throw out the hands in reverence and worship. {As throwing a spear}*  
(2 Chron 20:19, Ps 63:4)

**“TOWDAH”** - *Extend hands in adoration and thanksgiving.*  
(Psalm 50:23; 134:2; 141:2; 1 Tim 2:8)

**“TOGAH”** - *Extend the hands in thanksgiving*

## **Hebrew Words**

**“RAQAD”** - Spring about wildly for joy, dance jump, leap, skip. (1 Chron 15:29)



**“GUHL”** - Rejoice. Spin around, dance and twirl in a circular motion.

(Zeph 3:17, Ps 13:5, Ps 32:11)

**"ZAMAR"** - Touch the strings,  
Play musical instruments  
(Ps 150; 57:7-9; 92:1;  
1 Chron 15:16)



**"TEHILLAH"** - Singing of Halals,  
Singing in the Spirit/singing a  
new song. Unrehearsed,  
Intense, anointed, with a  
whole heart

(Ps 22:3, 100:4; 2 Chron 5:12-  
14; 20:22).

**“BARAK”** - *Kneel down, bless in adoration, be still and thank.*  
(Ps 72:12-15)

**“SHACHAH”** - *Bow down in reverence, be prostrate, beseech humbly.* (Lev 9:24)

**“PROSKUNEO”** - *Kiss towards. To fall on the knees touching the forehead on the ground as an expression of profound reverence.*

*Lit: To kiss as a dog licking his master's hand.* (Matt 2:11, John 4:23-24; 9:38, John 12:3, Rev 4:10, 5:14.)



***Acts 15:16-18 "After this I will return and rebuild David's fallen tent. Its ruins I will rebuild, and I will restore it, that the remnant of men may seek the Lord, and all the Gentiles who bear my name, says the Lord,..."***

## **David's Tent**

- **4000 Levites to play Instruments & sing**
- **Each had to be older than 30; 7 Years in school of the Prophets (under Samuel); Memorize entire scripture word-perfect.**
- **Divided into 24 teams to worship 1 hour per day: 24 hours a day; for 33 years**
- **Anyone had direct access to the most Holy Ark – presence of God; through worship. No Veil or wall separating.**
- **Every Hebrew word for Praise/Worship was demonstrated & practiced**
- **Most Psalms came forth spontaneously as "Tehillah"**

## **Tehillah!**

**LaMar Boschman: Tehillah means to Laud the divine in song, a hymn or praise – connected with the idea of a new or spontaneous song. We find further definition by its use in context of scripture: **Ps 40:3 “He has put a NEW SONG in my mouth; even TEHILLAH to our God”** {the fresh song that HE puts in our mouth. It is an unrehearsed song!}**

**Ps 22:3 “You are Holy; enthroned in (KJV You Inhabit) the Tehillah of Israel” He promised to dwell in Tehillah praise. He dwells in the spontaneous songs of His People. Some call it singing in the Spirit or a sacrifice of praise – it is a spontaneous song with no real pattern; when there is a spontaneous outburst in song by worshippers, often when a known song is finished.**

## ***Tehillah!***

***TEHILLAH Word Ministries: A spontaneous new song. Singing from a melody in your heart by adding words to it. This refers to a special kind of singing - it is singing unprepared, unrehearsed songs. Singing straight to God.***
